Overview

1 Ensure Hongkongers of all cultures and ethnicities are made to feel part of the Hong Kong family.

2 Preserve One Country, Two Systems in all respects as provided in the Basic Law.

Land and Housing

3. Urgently provide additional land for housing by developing new towns in the northern New Territories, with resolute use of land resumption powers.



4 Set a minimum size of apartment for residential use so as to provide a decent living environment for Hong Kong families, and remove any disincentive to raising a family.

Alleviation of Poverty

5. Move to improve livelihood and alleviate poverty among working poor and retirees by package of measures including programme of annual increases in minimum wage to reach \$60 per hour over the LegCo term, and encouraging employers to provide continued employment of their elderly workers and engage seniors wherever practical etc.

Growing the Economy

6. Promulgate the message to overseas and mainland companies and entrepreneurs that they are welcome to conduct business in Hong Kong and use the SAR as a base for China, especially the Greater Bay Area, and the region, and as a springboard for international markets.

7. Welcome talents from all four corners of the world to live and work in Hong Kong, as befits Asia's World City.
